



Protecting Youth in the Digital Age: NVE, Gore Groups, Sextortion and Human Trafficking

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This training addresses the growing risks youth face from 764-aligned networks, gore-based online groups, sextortion, trafficking, and online grooming occurring across gaming platforms and encrypted apps.

These networks are influencing youth locally, increasing suicide risk, and complicating first response. Awareness strengthens prevention and response.

Background

These are organized, coercive digital environments that:

- Encourage self-harm and suicide as proof of loyalty
- Normalize graphic violence
- Use sextortion, threats, and humiliation to control victims
- Promote retaliation and real-world harm

Community Impact

First responders are encountering youth connected to these networks during:

- Suicide attempts and crisis calls
- Self-harm investigations
- Sextortion and exploitation cases
- Violent threat investigations

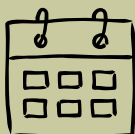


Training Takeaways
