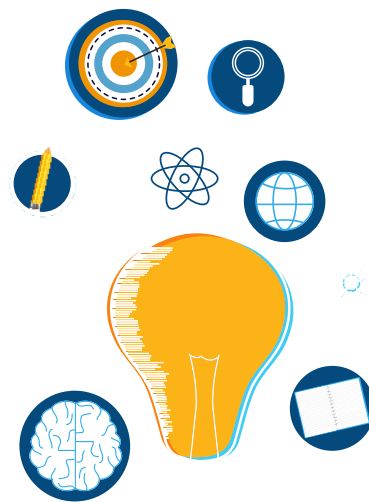


Tools that Work!

New teachers need specific support to put them on the road to teaching success — help get them there sooner with Tools that Work, a monthly training designed especially for novice teachers.

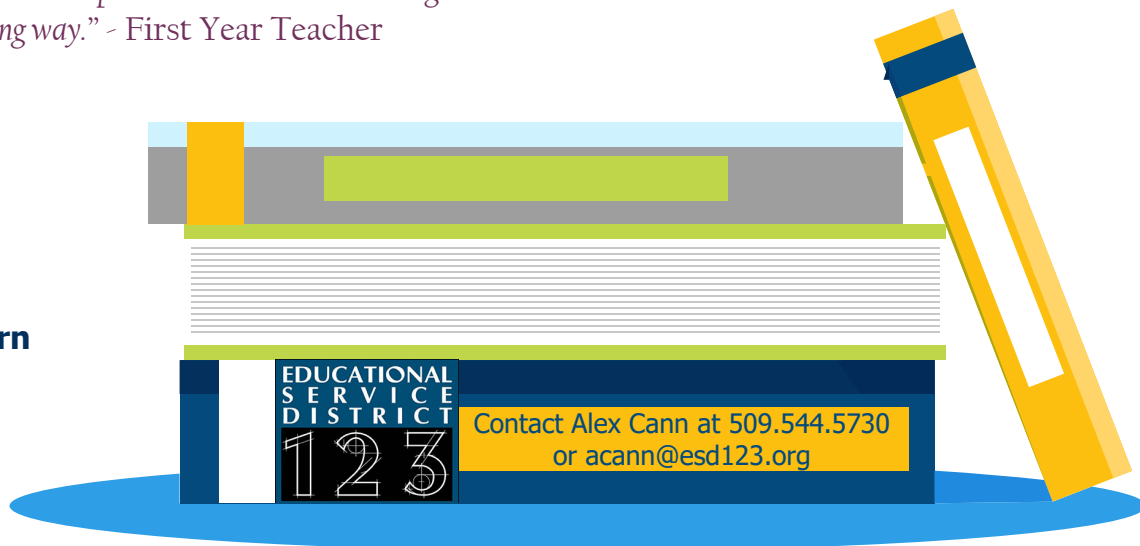
